You will visit and dine in the Skylon Tower, Niagara's most famous landmark, where on a clear day you can see close to 8,000 square miles of Canada and the United States, including the skylines of Toronto and Buffalo.

In Toronto you will explore the CN Tower, Parliament Buildings, High Park (the city's largest), the clamshell blocks of New City Hall, the enormous downtown banking district, the ultra-modern Sky Dome Stadium and the St. Lawrence Market. You will step back in time as we enter a world of imperial grace and splendor at Toronto's majestic landmark castle, Casa Loma (Spanish for "Castle on the Hill"). Canada's foremost castle is complete with decorated suites, secret passages, an 800-foot tunnel, towers, stables, and beautiful 5-acre estate gardens.

Due to the circumstances resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and the national emergency declaration, the Department of Homeland Security is extending the REAL ID enforcement deadline by a year. Beginning October 1, 2021, every air traveler 18 years of age and older will need a REAL ID-compliant driver's license, state-issued enhanced driver's license, or another acceptable from of ID to fly within the United States. US passports are Real ID-approved. This means that if you were to fly domestically and do not have a new ID, you can use your passport as a type of identification.
