I'm not sure when local Catholic parishes began auctioning quilts at their summer picnics, but my introduction to the practice came shortly after I joined the bank in 1991. I soon learned that most Sundays during "quilt season" (roughly June to September) were parish picnic days, and my dad would travel to one of the local towns for a great meal and a late afternoon quilt auction. Over the years he purchased scores of quilts both for himself and on behalf of the bank. Making a positive difference in the lives of our customers and our communities is one of our highest strategic objectives, and so it is our pleasure to be able to share







NOVEMBER

The perfect month to give thanks.

- Review your charitable giving and update any funding strategies, if needed.
- Watch for capital gains payouts. Investment companies typically distribute capital gains in December, and by November, they usually publish estimates of their distributions.
- Healthcare.gov open enrollment begins, Medicare Part A and B premiums and deductibles announced.

DECEMBER

End the year full of hope and goodwill.

- If you're 72 or older, don't forget to take your annual required minimum distribution (RMD) by December 31. If you turn 72 on July 1, 2022, or later, you do not need to take an RMD until April 1, 2023.
- You can request an annual Social Security Statement. Compare your earnings record against your old tax returns for accuracy. This is also an excellent time to check for other irregularities to prevent identity theft.
