Perryville -

A town of Patriotism, German Heritage, Agriculture, and Faith April 19-20, 2023

Join us as we explore Perryville, a historically rich town situated on the banks of the Mississippi River. We will tour Missouri's National Veterans Memorial, which has a full-size replica of the Vietnam Memorial. Besides the famous wall, there are flag memorials for all branches of service, a visitor center, pavilion, and a museum. We will visit the National Shrine





of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, also called Saint Mary's of the Barrens, a historic Roman Catholic Church, grotto, and Rosary Walk located on 55 acres in Perryville. This peaceful place was founded in 1818 with the construction of a small log church and a seminary. At the American Tractor Museum, you will tour an amazing collection as you walk through the evolution of the machine that plowed, planted, and harvested the American dream for centuries. See one of the largest and most unique collections of its kind featuring rare manufacturers such as Rumely, Waterloo



Boy, Illinois, Indiana, Huber, Plymouth, Avery, Rock Island, Greyhound, Centaur and many more! You will visit The Saxon Lutheran Memorial which commemorates the German Lutheran migration of 1838 – 1839 to the Perry County area. In 1838 approximately 700 German-Lutherans left their homes, farms, businesses, and all they knew behind and settled in St. Louis and then Perry County. The Memorial features several log cabins and artifacts from that era. Enjoy this two-day getaway as we explore Perryville and its surrounding areas.
