## Weston to St. Joseph, MO

May 1-2, 2024

From a cute American town of another era to a city that was once a home to outlaws, pioneers and uber-wealthy merchants and is now equal parts charm and quirk. Join us as we learn about the history of Weston and St. Joseph, Missouri.

We will begin with a visit to Green Dirt Farm, where we will tour the farm, get a glimpse of the milking parlor and a view into the cheese kitchen before enjoying lunch at the Green Dirt Farm café where we will get a taste of the award winning sheep cheeses. We will spend some time in the afternoon learning the history of Lewis & Clark, Irish immigration, and the Black History of Weston from our personal guide. After some time exploring the shops of Weston we will travel to St. Joseph. Here we will check into the place where the Pony Express began and Jesse James ended, the Stoney Creek Inn. We will end the evening with dinner at Jake's Steak house.

Day two will be packed with history and mystery as we tour the museums of St. Jo. We begin with the Patee House/Jesse James Home, we will enjoy lunch and a tour of the Wyeth-Tootle Mansion, followed by a visit to the Pony Express Museum and end our day with Murder at the Asylum, an interactive Clue Game and tour of the Glore Psychiatric Museum.
