Now is the time to enjoy the opportunity to travel, learn and have fun with your Advantage Club friends or invite a friend of your own, and we will do all the planning for you!





At the creamery everyone enjoyed a delicious lunch of charcuterie boards to share featuring their award winning sheep cheeses, The Woolly One grilled cheese and the GDF Tomato Soup. The chef, Fin, was kind enough to share the GDF Tomato Soup recipe.

In a true chef style, no measurements were given unless stated. I am not a chef, so I am presenting the recipe as I received it. I hope you are brave enough to give it a try and to share your results when you do as it was absolutely delicious!

GDF Tomato Soup Recipe

Ingredients:

2 Cans Alta Cucina Tomatoes *(or similar quality)* Sweet Onion 2 Whole Garlic, diced Fresh Basil Spices *(see below)* Vegetable Stock Heavy Whipping Cream

Instructions:

- Sauté onions until gold and transparent
- Add garlic and chopped fresh basil, cook 2 minutes
- Add salt, coarse ground black pepper, Italian
- seasoning, red pepper flakes and paprika (all to taste)
- Add whole tomatoes and bring to a boil
- \cdot $\,$ Puree the tomatoes with an immersion blender
- Add 1 gallon of vegetable stock + water
- Stir in heavy whipping cream
