CAPE GIRARDEAU Step Back in Time April 30 - May 1, 2025

Discover more than 250 years of history, ranging from Mississippian life to a visit from Lewis & Clark on their journey west to words from Mark Twain and a Victorian house museum – as well as everything in between and beyond.

We will begin discovering the prominent attractions of Cape during a personal city tour with a step-on guide. Followed by a visit to the Red House Interpretive Center that commemorates the life of Cape Girardeau's

founder Louis Lormier as well as Lewis and Clark's visit to the community on November 23, 1803. Finish day one with a delicious meal and a great river view while a talented musician and storyteller weaves a tall tale of life gone by in Cape Girardeau.

On day two, experience the Civil War at Fort D, an earthenworks fort that defended Cape Girardeau from the Confederate forces. Experience the life of a well-to-do family during the Victorian Era at the beautifully restored Glenn House, where you'll find cuttingedge 19th century tech and period furnishings. Then visit Riverside Pottery where the owner will tell you about the different facets of pottery and the history of the building. View over one hundred medieval design plaster masks portraying characters from the Miracle and Mystery plays, distinctive wrought iron designs, meticulously hand-carved doors and exquisite Italian Renaissance architecture all contributing to the breathtaking atmosphere inside and out Old St. Vincent's Church. We will finish our time in Cape with a visit to the Cape River Heritage Museum. Located in an old fire station, the museum is

packed with exhibits illustrating life in Cape Girardeau, from the start of the community to the age of the steamboats and beyond.

Advantage Club members enjoyed three nights at the historic Palmer House Hilton when they traveled to Chicago in June. They had an opportunity to try the wonderful original culinary invention that came from the Palmer House kitchen in 1893, the brownie. It is said that Bertha Palmer asked the house pastry chef to create a dessert for ladies attending the Chicago World's Columbian Exposition. She wanted a simple, cake-like confection that could be transported to the fair in a boxed lunch. Below is the recipe as published on the Palmer House Hotels website.

Palmer House Hotel Brownies

INGREDIENTS:

5.25 oz 60% Dark Couverture Chocolate 9.75 oz butter 12.75 oz granulated sugar 5 eggs

3.5 oz all-purpose flour1/8 tsp baking powder8 oz chopped walnuts

FOR THE GLAZE:

1 C water 1 C apricot preserves 1 tsp unflavored gelatin



Mix water, apricot preserves, and unflavored gelatin in saucepan. Mix thoroughly and bring to a boil for two minutes. Brush hot glaze on brownies while still warm.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

2. Melt chocolate and butter in a double boiler. Mix the baking powder, sugar and flour together in a bowl. Combine chocolate and flour mixtures. Sir for 4 to 5 minutes. Add eggs and continue mixing.

3. Pour the mixture into a 9X12 baking sheet. Sprinkle walnuts on top, pressing down slightly into the mixture with your hand. Bake for approximately 35 minutes.

4. Brownies are done when the edges begin to crisp and has risen about $1\!\!\!/_4$ of an inch.

Note: When the brownie is properly baked, it will remain "gooey" with a toothpick in the middle due to the richness of the mixture.
