Upon arrival in Washington, we'll head north to the



history of the Missouri River Valley. The home itself is a wonderful piece of historic architecture, designed by Theodore Link, architect of Union Station in St. Louis. Lunch will be served at the Old Barn Inn, the historic day trip destination for some of St. Louis' wealthiest families during the 1930's, 40's and 50's. We'll end our time in the historical upscale community with time to visit their two adorable shops.

Next, we will visit a beautiful, unique, and fun boutique that features a Beer & Wine Bar. At the Milk and Honey Store you will paint (and eat) some cookies at your private Christmas Cookies in July event.

A Treat from our Travels...

During our Springtime in the South tour, we enjoyed the heart of the French Quarter, with a memorable stop at the New Orleans School of Cooking. We didn't just experience a simple cooking demonstration; we were treated to a story-filled gathering, with a local chef leading the way. We learned not just how to prepare classic Cajun and Creole dishes, but why they matter - how food, family, and history are deeply entwined in New Orleans culture.

In true Advantage Club fashion, we shared laughs and great food, leaving us with full bellies and full hearts. One dish that stole the show was the Bananas Foster. The demonstration was as impressive as the dessert was delicious.

Bananas Foster

INGREDIENTS:

8 tbs (1 stick) unsalted butter 1 C dark brown sugar, packed

2 oz banana liqueur

2 small bananas, slicked into 1/2" coins

4 oz spiced rum ground cinnamon vanilla bean ice cream



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a medium saucepan or skillet set on medium heat, melt butter and sugar together until a smooth paste forms, about 2-3 minutes.
- 2. Stir in the banana liqueur and bananas. Increase the heat to medium-high.
- 3. Carefully pour the rum along the inside rim of the pan, When the mixture comes to a simmer, gently shake the pan. If it is safe to do so, ignite the mixture with a long lighter. Otherwise, allow the rum to simmer for a few minutes to cook off some of the alcohol, or add the rum to the sauce after it is cooked.
- 4. Gently shake the pan while sprinkling the cinnamon into the flames. (Again, only if safe to do so)
- 5. Allow the flame to burn out, then simmer until the sauce has reached your desired consistency. Remove from heat and let the bubbling to stop before pouring the sauce over vanilla bean ice cream.





site of the English settlers' first arrival in 1607. The day concludes with a special evening at the charming Mermaid Winery, where we'll enjoy a private wine tasting paired with a custom dinner experience.

Beginning May 7, 2025, every state and territory resident will need to present a REAL ID compliant license/ID, or another acceptable form of identification **for boarding ANY commercial aircraft.** The card must be REAL ID compliant unless the resident is using an alternative acceptable document such as a passport or passport card.

Visit your state's drivers licensing agency website to find out exactly what documentation is required to obtain a REAL ID. REAL ID- compliant cards will have a particular marking (gold or black star, gold or black circle with a white star inside) on the upper portion of the card.
