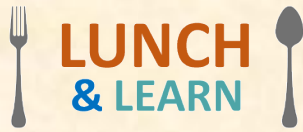
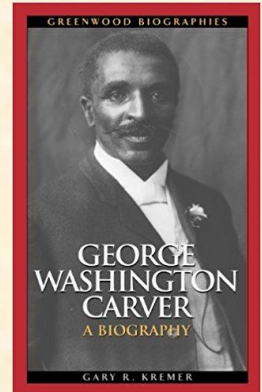
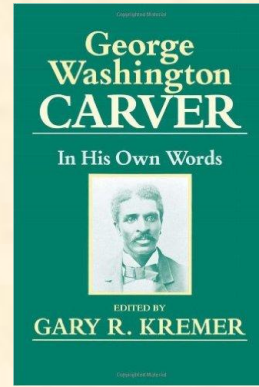

Don't miss this special opportunity to hear from one of Missouri's most respected historians, Dr. Gary Kremer, Executive Director of the State Historical Society of Missouri. Before he steps down from his long-held leadership role, Dr. Kremer will join us to share personal stories and historical insights at our August Lunch & Learn.

A fifth-generation Missourian, Gary was born and raised in Osage County and will reflect on his experiences growing up in the Linn and Frankenstein areas during the 1950s and early 1960s. His legendary storytelling will take us back to a different time in rural Missouri.

Dr. Kremer has dedicated his life to education and preservation, having taught at Lincoln University and William Woods University, served as Missouri's State Archivist, and written, coauthored and coedited twelve books. His most recent book, *This Place of Promise: A Historian's Perspective on 200 years of Missouri History* shares his knowledge and personal experiences as he considers what being a Missourian has meant to all the state's people.
