June 17-21, 2026

The next day, that patriotic celebration kicks into high gear as we witness the Parade of Sail - a breathtaking procession of tall ships gliding past the point where the Chesapeake Bay meets the James and Elizabeth Rivers. With reserved seating at Fort Monroe, we'll have a front-row view of this once-in-a-generation spectacle. Afterward, we head into Norfolk's vibrant Harborfest, exploring the waterfront and getting up close with many of the ships we saw in the parade. The day continues with a visit to Nauticus and the mighty Battleship Wisconsin, followed by a scenic narrated cruise around the world's largest naval base - an incredible way to see these magnificent vessels from the water. Dinner this evening will cap off a truly memorable day of American pride and maritime tradition.

Next, we venture beyond Virginia to the breathtaking Outer Banks of North Carolina. We'll start at the Wright Brothers National Memorial, where flight first took off in 1903. A park ranger will guide us through the story of that historic moment, complete with reconstructed campsites and markers of the original flight paths. Later, we head to Corolla for a thrilling open-air safari in search of the wild Colonial Spanish Mustangs that roam freely among the dunes and beaches. These majestic creatures - protected and untouched - are a living link to the past and a true highlight of our journey. After dinner, we'll return to Norfolk with full hearts and incredible memories.

As our trip draws to a close, we'll make our way home, reflecting on the unforgettable experiences we've shared. From towering tall ships and historic lighthouses to wild horses and soaring warbirds, this adventure is a powerful tribute to America's spirit and story. History of Missouri Wines

While many of us may enjoy an occasional glass of wine, you may not know that wine in Missouri has a long and storied history. In 1837 German Settlers established the town of Hermann on the banks of the Missouri River. Although the area was too rocky for many crops, the ground was well-suited for growing wine grapes. Within a decade, the settlers had established nearly sixty wineries in the Hermann area and produced more than 10,000 gallons of wine per year. Fast forward 180 years to 2017 and the Missouri wine and grape industry generates \$3.2 billion for the Show-Me State, \$1 billion in annual wages, over 28,000 jobs and brings in more than 800,000 tourists each year.

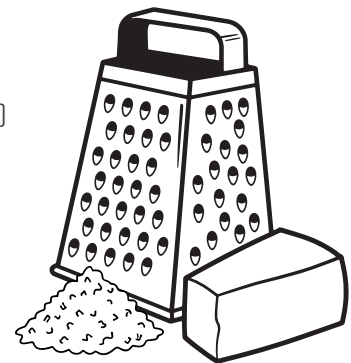
The Advantage Club brought the appetite and Carmine's brought the "wow-factor" making the meal feel like an Italian American wedding feast.

Golden Chicken Parmigiana

Serves: 2-3 Cook time: 40 minutes

INGREDIENTS:

- | | |
|----------------------------|---|
| 1 C flour | 2 C Carmine's marinara sauce (or sauce of choice) |
| 2 Large eggs | 5-6 1/4 inch thick slices of mozzarella (about 7 oz total) |
| 3 C of breadcrumbs | 2 5 oz chicken breast pounded to 1/4 inch thickness between 2 pieces of waxed paper |
| 1/2 C vegetable oil | |
| 2 tbs grated Romano cheese | |



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 450* or preheat the broiler.
2. Spread the flour on a large plate. Whisk the eggs in a shallow bowl. Spread the breadcrumbs on a baking sheet.
3. Season the cutlets with salt and pepper. Coat them with flour and shake off any excess. Dip them in the egg mixture and let any excess drip off. Press the cutlets into the breadcrumbs, making sure they are covered with breadcrumbs on both sides. Set them aside on a plate. Refrigerate for 2 to 3 hours until needed.
4. In a large sauté' pan, heat the oil over medium heat. When the oil is hot, add the cutlets and cook them for about 3 minutes on each side or until they are a deep golden brown all over. Transfer them to paper towels to drain.
5. Meanwhile, in a medium sized saucepan, heat the marinara sauce over medium-high heat for 4 to 5 minutes or until hot.
6. Transfer the cutlets to a shallow ovenproof casserole dish. Place the mozzarella on top and sprinkle it with grated cheese.
7. Transfer the cutlets to the oven and cook them for 3 to 4 minutes or until the cheese is melted. If you are cooking under the broiler, this will take 2 to 3 minutes.
8. Ladle the sauce onto a large platter. Place the cutlets on top of the sauce and serve.

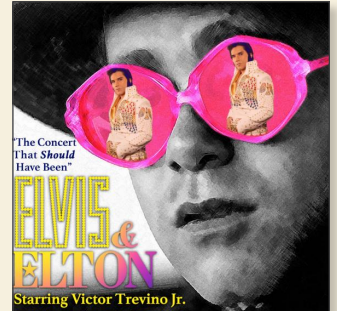

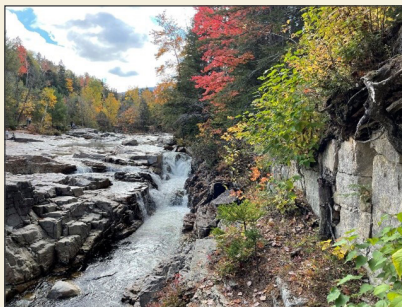
