Thursday, August 19 (Kickback Reception)

Mid-afternoon we will transfer to the **Drury Inn St. Louis Airport**. Join your traveling companions for the hotel's complimentary **Kickback Reception** offering hot food and cold drinks.

Friday, August 20 (Breakfast, Dinner)

Our Montana adventure begins today as we fly to **Kalispell**, a charming town known as the Gateway to Glacier National Park. From there, we'll travel to the picturesque mountain town of **Whitefish** and settle into **Grouse Mountain Lodge**, our home for the next two nights. Surrounded by towering pines and Rocky Mountain scenery, it's the perfect place to relax before our big adventures ahead. This evening, we'll gather for a **welcome dinner** at the lodge.

Saturday, August 21 (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, we'll visit the **Conrad Mansion Museum** in downtown Kalispell. This beautifully preserved 26-room Victorian mansion, built by Kalispell founder Charles E. Conrad, offers a glimpse into privileged life in 19th century Montana and is one of Flathead Valley's most notable historic homes. All three floors of the home have been fully restored, and over 90% of the furniture, clothing, toys, and books are original to the house.

Alternatively, relax at the Grouse Mountain Lodge or choose your own mini-adventure (additional fees apply): play a round of golf, go kayaking or fishing on Whitefish lake, or soar through the trees on a high-speed zipline.

This afternoon we make our way to **Downtown Whitefish**, where you'll have free time to browse the shops and enjoy lunch on your own before departing for our **Scenic River Float Trip**. Settle in for a peaceful float along the crystal-clear middle fork of the Flathead River as knowledgeable local guides share the beauty and serenity of Montana's spectacular landscape. After our time on the water, enjoy a relaxed **riverside dinner** featuring fresh ingredients and genuine Western hospitality - the perfect ending to a memorable Montana evening.



Sunday, August 22 (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, we depart Whitefish and travel to **Lake McDonald Lodge**, a historic 1914 Swiss chalet-style hotel nestled on Lake McDonald in **Glacier National Park**. We will board the iconic **red buses** for a **narrated, scenic tour** along the amazing **Going-To-The-Sun Road**. As much of the park's scenery is vertically oriented, the roll-back tops are perfect for taking in the full grandeur of the rugged mountains, cascading waterfalls, and the area's signature Big Sky. Keep your eyes peeled for mountain goats, marmot, and bighorn sheep during our 3-hour ride.

After time for lunch in St. Mary Village, we depart for **Great Falls** and check into the **Hilton Garden Inn** for one night. **Dinner** is included this evening at a local restaurant, where we'll reflect on our day in the crown jewel of the Rockies.





Monday, August 23 (Breakfast, Box Lunch)

Today we'll drive southward to the **Gates of the Mountains Recreation Area** for a **river cruise** along a picturesque stretch of the **Missouri River**. Named by Lewis and Clark, this canyon offers steep limestone cliffs, crystal-clear water, and abundant wildlife including mountain goats and bald eagles. After our cruise, enjoy a box lunch before boarding the coach to make our scenic journey to **Big Sky**. This afternoon we check into **The Wilson Hotel** for three nights. This fabulous hotel is located in the heart of Big Sky's downtown, featuring dozens of nearby shops and restaurants and panoramic views of the area's mountain tops. After settling into your spacious, comfortable room, enjoy a relaxing evening at the hotel or venture out to explore the vibrant atmosphere of Big Sky.



Tuesday, August 24 (Breakfast)

We start our day with a breakfast buffet at the hotel. **Included today is an adventure of your choice!** Saddle up for a **guided horseback ride** (*availability is limited*) through the majestic Custer Gallatin National Forest, where winding trails and panoramic vistas capture the spirit of the American West. Or, rise above the clouds on the **Lone Peak Tram** at **Big Sky Resort**. At the top of Loan Peak Mountain sits **Kircliff**, a glass observatory at 11,166 feet that offers 360-degree views of ten mountain ranges, two national parks, and three states!

Then we're off to **West Yellowstone**. Along the way, enjoy a fascinating film on Yellowstone National Park that beautifully introduces the wonders we'll explore tomorrow. Stroll the lively streets for handcrafted gifts that make the perfect souvenir and savor lunch at one of the town's rustic grills or western-style eateries. We'll then gather at the **Grizzly and Wolf Discovery Center**, where rescued animals educate visitors about conservation and coexistence in the wild. A free evening awaits you back in Big Sky. Take time to unwind beside an outdoor firepit beneath Montana's legendary "Big Sky" sunset.

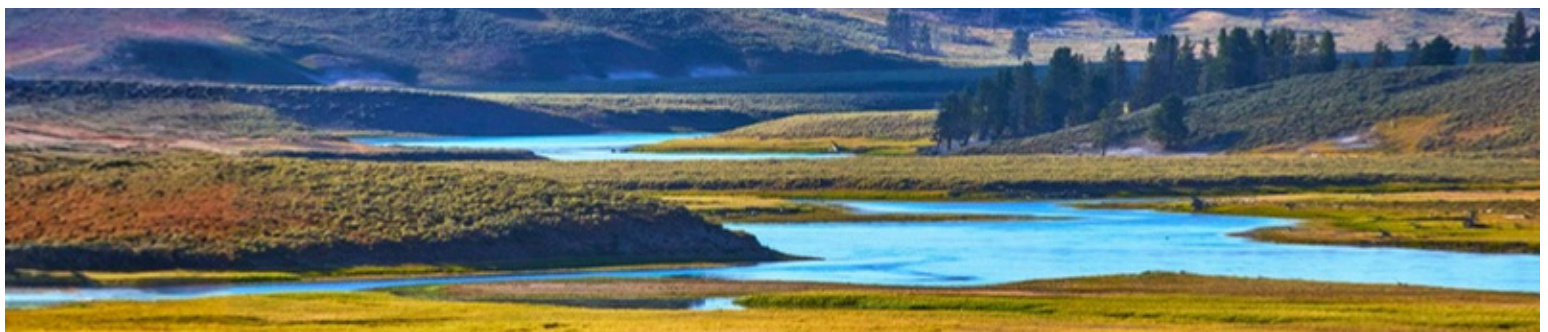
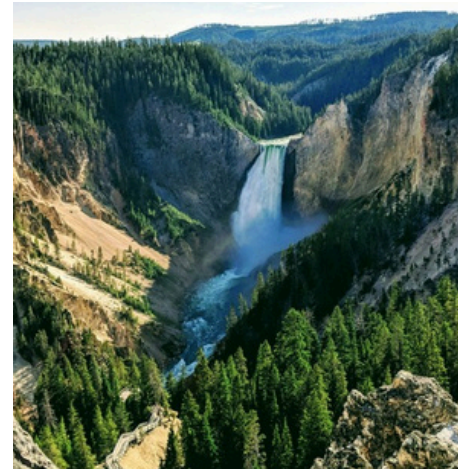
Wednesday, August 25 (Breakfast, Dinner)

Enjoy breakfast this morning before we set out on a **full-day guided tour of Yellowstone National Park**, the world's first national park. Entering through West Yellowstone, we'll explore the park's southern region, home to steaming geyser basins, colorful hot springs, and lush meadows. Marvel at the **Upper & Lower Falls of the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone**, tranquil **Yellowstone Lake**, the **Continental Divide**, and of course, Yellowstone's most famous attraction - **Old Faithful**, which never fails to impress! There will be plenty of time to have lunch and shop for souvenirs along the way.

We exit the park by early evening and gather for one last **dinner** as a group, celebrating our unforgettable adventure. Afterward, you're free to enjoy more of Big Sky's nightlife and soak in the vibrant mountain-town atmosphere near the hotel.

Thursday, August 26 (Breakfast)

This morning after breakfast we bid farewell to Montana as we head to the Bozeman airport for our flight home. We'll be taking home not just souvenirs, but countless wonderful memories of our Magnificent Montana vacation - from towering peaks and sparkling lakes to wildlife encounters and the boundless big sky itself!
